Sixth version of the Addiction Severity Index Eighty percent of patients were male, had a mean age of 40.49 years, and were never married (40.3%). Almost half of the participants had less than elementary education (48.9%) and 43.0% of the sample worked full time at baseline. About 7% had a physical and 6% a psychological disability.

Thomas McLellan, a man known for his pioneering work in the field of addiction treatment and specifically the development of two interview-based modalities to measure addiction severity and treatment needs: the ASI and the Treatment Services Review (TSR).
