Securing Crete would be tantamount to driving the British out of the eastern Mediterranean; it would also be the first step towards German control of Cyprus and the Suez Canal. The battle, which started on May 20 and ended on June 1, 1941, was dubbed "The Graveyard of the Fallschirmjäger" (the German parachutists known as "Sky Hunters").
