This then ushered the factory system, which was key to the Industrial Revolution. The defining invention of the Industrial Revolution was perhaps the Steam Engine of James Watt in late 1760s which was primarily invented to pull water from the coal mines. However, it also powered the textile industry with innovations like the power mule and power loom. The steam powered engine allowed industries to move away from water (water frames were used).
