Works Cited page. The list of works cited is included on a separate page at the end of your paper. You list all sources you referenced in your paper in alphabetical order. Don't include sources that were only consulted. Place the title "Works Cited" in the center at the top of the page.

If you have come across a reference from one paper (A) that has been cited in another paper (B), then A is the primary source while B is the secondary source. In such cases, you must first read the original paper or primary source (A) and ensure that the context of the citation has been correctly presented in B.
